Peter 1:3-4 Jesus has the power of God. His power has given us everything we need to live and to serve God. We have these things because we know him Through his glory and goodness, he gave us the very great and rich gifts he promised us. With those gifts you can share in God's nature. And so the world will not ruin you with its evil desires.

Hebrews 11:8-10 It was by faith Abraham obeyed God's call to go to another place that God promised to give him He lived in tents with Isaac and Jacob, who had received that same promise rom God. Abraham was waiting for the city that has real foundations—the city planned and built by God.

Friday, January 3, 2025 Genesis 12:1-3
Then the Lord said to Abram, "Leave your country, your relatives and your father's family. Go to the land I will show you. I will make you a great nation, and I will bless you. I will make you famous. And you will be a blessing to others. I will bless those who bless you. I will place a curse on those who harm you. And all the people on earth wi be blessed through you."

Hebrews 11:11-12 It was by faith that Abraham was made able to become a father. Abraham trusted Good to do what he had promised. This man was so old that he was almost dead. But from him came as many descendants as there are stars in the sky. They are as many as the grains of sand on the seashore that cannot be counted.

Saturday, January 4, 2025

Sunday, January 5, 2025 Genesis 15:5-6 Then God led Abram outside. God said, "Look at the sky. There are so many stars you cannot count them. And your descendants will be too many to count." Abram believed the Lord. And the Lord accepted Abram's faith, and that faith made him right with God.

Monday, January 6, 2025 Joshua 21:43-45 So the Lord kept the promise he had made to the Israelites. He gave the people all the land he had promised The Lord allowed them to have peace on all sides of their land. This is what he had promised to their people who lived long ago The Lord allowed the Israelites to defeat every enemy. He kept every promise he had made to the Israelites

Tuesday, January 7, 2025 Joel 2:32
Then anyone who asks the Lord for help will be saved. Even on Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there will be people who will be saved. This will happen just as the Lord has said. Those left alive after the day of punishment are the people whom the Lord called.
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Wednesday, January 8, 2025 Romans 10:13 The Scripture says, "Anyone who asks the Lord for help will be saved."

Thursday, January 9, 2025
Acts 2:38-39 Peter said to them, "Change your hearts and lives and be baptized, each one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. This promise is for you. It is also for your children and for all who are far away. It is for everyone the Lord our God calls to himself."

Friday, January 10, 2025 1 John 2:24-25
Be sure that you continue to follow the teaching that you heard from the beginning. If you continue in that teaching, you will stay in the Son and in the Father. And this is what the Son promised to us—life forever.
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Galatians 3:13-14 So the law put a curse on us, but Christ took away that curse. He changed places with us and put himself under that curse Christ did this so that God's blessing promised to Abraham might come to the non-Jews. This blessing comes through Jesus Christ. Jesus died so that we could have the Spirit that God promised and receive this promise by believing.

Galatians 3:15-16 Brothers, let me give you an example: Think about an agreement that a person makes with another person. After that agreement is accepted by both people, no one can stop that agreement or add anything to it. God made promises to Abraham and his descendant

Tuesday, January 14, 2025 Galatians 3:17-18
This is what I mean: God had an agreement with Abraham and promised to keep it. The law, which came 430 years later, cannot change God's promise to Abraham. Can following the law give us what God promised? No! If this is so, it is not God's promise that brings us the blessings. Instead God freely gave his blessings to Abraham through the promise he had made.

Galatians 3:19-20 So what was the law for? The law was given to show the wrong things people do. It continued until the special descendant of Abraham came. God's promise was about this descendant. The law was given through angels who used Moses for a mediator to give the law to men. But a mediator is not needed when there is only one side. And God is only one.

Galatians 3:21-22 Does this mean that the law is against God's promises? Never! If there were a law that could give men life, then we could be made right by following that law. But this is not true, because the Scriptures showed that the whole world is bound by sin. This was so that the promise would be given through faith. And it is given to people who believe in Jesus Christ.

Friday, January 17, 2025 Galatians 3:23-25 Before this faith came, we were all held prisoners by the law. We had no freedom until God
showed us the way of faith that was coming. So the law was our master until Christ came. After Christ came, we could be made right with God through faith. Now the way of faith has come, and we no longer live under the law.
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Saturday, January 18, 2025 Galatians 3:26-27, 29 You were all baptized into Christ, and so you were all clothed with Christ. This shows that you are all children of God through faith in Christ Jesus You belong to Christ. So you are Abraham's descendants. You get all of God's blessings because of the promise that God made to Abraham.

Hebrews 6:10-12 God is fair. He will not forget the work you did and the love you showed for him by helping his beople. And he will remember that you are still helping them. We want each of you to go on with the same hard work all your lives. Then you will surely get what you hope for. We do not want you to become lazy. Be like those who have faith and patience. They will receive what God has promised.

Monday, January 20, 2025 Hebrews 6:13-15 God made a promise to Abraham. And as there is no one greater than God, he used himself when he swore to Abraham. He said, "I will surely bless you and give you many descendants." Abraham waited patiently for this to happen. And he received what God
promised.
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Hebrews 6:18 These two things cannot change. God cannot lie when he makes a promise, and he cannot lie when he makes an oath. These things encourage us who came to God for safety. They give us strength to hold on to the hope we have been given.

Wednesday, January 22, 2025 Hebrews 6:19-20
We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, sure and strong. It enters behind the curtain in the Most Holy Place in heaven. Jesus has gone in there ahead of us and for us. He has become the high priest forever, a priest like Melchizedek.
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Friday, January 24, 2025 Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold firmly to the hope that we have confessed. We can trust God to do what he promised.	
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Saturday, January 25, 2025 Hebrews 10:34-36
You helped the prisoners. And you even had joy when all that you owned was taken from you. You were joyful because you knew that you had something better and more lasting. So do not lose the courage that you had in the past. It has a great reward. You must hold on, so you can do what God wants and receive what he has promised.

Sunday, January 26, 2025 Hebrews 10:37-39 For in a very short time, "The One who is coming will come. He will not be late. The person who is right with me will have life because of his faith. But if he turns back with fear, I will not be pleased with him." But we are not those who turn back and are lost. We are people who have faith and are saved.

Monday, January 27, 2025  James 1:12  When a person is tempted and still continues strong, he should be happy. After he has broved his faith, God will reward him with life forever. God promised this to all people who ove him.

Tuesday, January 28, 2025 2 Corinthians 6:17-7:1 "Leave those people, and make yourselves pure, says the Lord. Touch nothing that is unclean, and I will accept you. I will be your father, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord All-Powerful." Dear friends, we have these promises from God. So we should make ourselves pure—free from anything that makes body or soul unclean. We should try to become perfect in the way we live, because we respect God.

Wednesday, January 29, 2025
2 Peter 3:9-10 The Lord is not slow in doing what he promised—the way some people understand slowness. But God is being patient with you. He does not want anyone to be lost. He wants everyone to change his heart and life. But the day the Lord comes again will be a surprise, like a thief. The skies will disappear with a loud noise. Everything in the skies will be destroyed by fire. And the earth and everything in it will be exposed.

2 Peter 3:11-13 In that way everything will be destroyed. So what kind of people should you be? You should live holy lives and serve God. You should wait for the day of God and look forward to its coming. When that day comes, the skies will be destroyed with fire, and everything in the skies will melt with heat. But God made a promise to us. And we are waiting for what he promised—a new heaven and a new earth where goodness lives.
